DAY 2: SMALL THINGS MATTER

Read Matthew 13:31–32 Nlrv

God's Kingdom doesn't always look big or impressive at first. Sometimes it starts with something so small that people barely notice. But God loves using small beginnings to do great things. God celebrates starts, not just finishes. You don't have to wait until you're older, louder, or braver. Jesus shows us that God's Kingdom often begins with small steps taken in faith.

DAY 3: GOD'S KINGDOM GROWS INSIDE YOU

Read Luke 17:20–21 Nlrv

God's Kingdom is not just something we see one day in the future. Jesus showed us that God's Kingdom begins in our hearts. When you choose love, patience, or kindness, God's Kingdom is growing inside you.

Sometimes growth is slow, like waiting for dough to rise. You can't rush it, but you can trust that God is working. Even when you don't feel different right away, God's Spirit is shaping you to be more like Jesus. Following Jesus means letting God change you from the inside out so His love can shine through you.

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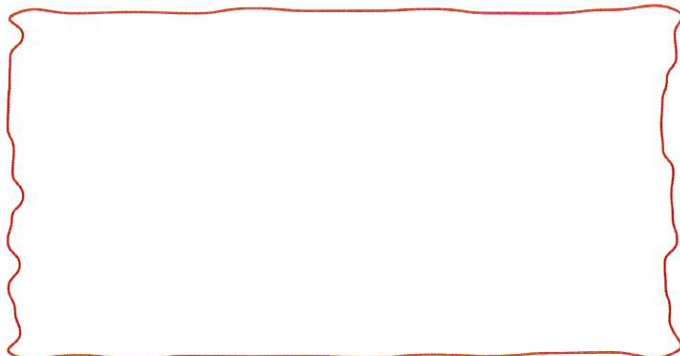

DAY 2: THE BEST GIFT

Read Ephesians 2:8 NlrV

God wants to give everyone the best gift ever. God gave us Jesus to make a way for everyone to be part of God's family forever! Jesus came to earth and gave His life for us. We don't have to try to be good enough, smart enough, or loving enough. This is a gift we can't earn. It's about what Jesus has done.

DAY 3: JESUS MADE A WAY

Read Romans 5:8 NlrV

Have you ever been somewhere you couldn't get into—like a building that was locked or a place you needed a special pass to enter? You couldn't get in on your own. You needed help. The Bible teaches us that God's Kingdom is perfect and holy. Because we all make mistakes, we can't enter God's Kingdom by ourselves. But here's the good news: Jesus made the way! Jesus came to earth, lived a perfect life, died on the cross for our sins, and rose again. Because of what Jesus did, we can be forgiven and welcomed into God's Kingdom. We don't earn it by being perfect—we receive it by trusting Jesus. When we believe in Jesus, we become part of God's family and His Kingdom. That means we live for Him, follow His ways, and share His love with others every day.

Read 1 Timothy 1:15 NlrV

The apostle Paul explained why Jesus came. Jesus didn't

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DAY 2: WHAT GOD IS LIKE

Read John 14:8-9 NlrV

Have you ever wondered what God is like? Is He kind? Is He patient? Does He care about people who are left out? One day, Jesus' friends asked Him that same question. Jesus told them something amazing. When you look at Jesus, you are seeing what God is like. Jesus didn't just talk about God's Kingdom. He lived it.

Everywhere Jesus went, He showed God's Kingdom by loving people, helping the hurting, forgiving sins, and welcoming those others ignored. When Jesus showed compassion, that was God's Kingdom in action. When

Jesus healed, forgave, or invited people close, He was showing what life with God looks like. If you want to know how to live in God's Kingdom, look at Jesus. The more you learn from Him, the more you understand God's heart.

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DAY 2: WORTH EVERYTHING

Read Luke 4:18–19 Nlrv

When Jesus began His ministry, He explained why He came. He said He was sent to bring good news, help people who were hurting, and set things right. That's what God's Kingdom looks like in real life.

Jesus didn't just talk about God's Kingdom. He showed it by what He did. He cared for people who were sick, lonely, or ignored. He treated everyone with love and respect. Everywhere Jesus went, God's Kingdom followed. When you choose kindness, help someone in need, or stand up for what's right, you're loving God's Kingdom too. You don't have to be perfect. You just have to follow Jesus and live the way He taught.

Read Matthew 13:45–46 Nlrv

The man searching for pearls knew what he was looking for. When he found the perfect pearl, he didn't hesitate. He gave up everything else to keep it.
